Wow, what a successful tournament. Credible Yellowfin captures, a Bluefin, Shark and Mahi Mahi were all on offer. Three days of great fishing, the first two in glass conditions with Monday also presenting great seas for fishing.



Boats went wide to find the elusive Yellowfin Schools and success was found along the 1000 fathom line. Adventurous boats went to the 2000 fathom line where Bluefin and Yellowfin were also found.

17 Teams registered for the tournament with a total of 54 anglers.

A very warm welcome to the new teams that sought us out and participated both on the water and during our social events. Great to see fresh enthusiastic new faces.

Also a very warm welcome to the ex Eden Gamefishing Club members. It's a shame to see a club have to close its doors but a pleasure to welcome you to the MBGLAC.

The first day of the tournament was by far the busies perspective. Thirteen Yellowfin and one Bluefin were boated or tagged during the day with the weigh station kept very busy after lines up till well past 8pm.

The seas were glass so boats fished right to the end with very long trips back to

their trailers or moorings and then the drive back to the scales.

Saturday nights weigh in was an emotional time with the weigh in going well into the night and full of frustrations of fish just missing out on going line class.

Successful boats for the three days included Dog Fossil skippered by Stewart Jeffrey, Sea Hog Skippered by Trevor Chippendale, The Jenks skippered by Nigel Hack, Reel Jem skippered by Polly, Cassie Skippered by Shane Mayberry and Snappy Tom Skippered by Rob Wood.

Commendable fish were landed by Stewart Green, Leaf Miller, Andrew Walker, Trevor Chippendale, Stewart Jeffrey, Ian Gullock and Junior Joel Woolley.



Captured and tag and release fish total numbers were:

- 8 Captured Yellowfin Tuna
- 1 captured Bluefin Tuna
- 5 tag and release Yellowfin Tuna.
- 2 tag and release Shortbill Spearfish
- 4 tag and release Mahi Mahi
- 3 measure and release Striped Tuna
- 1 tag and release Bronze Whaler





Other notable captures include junior York Chippendale with a 23.5kg Yellowfin on 24kg line. The Weighmaster placed the fish on the scales multiple times and along with all bystanders willed the necessary extra 0.5kg to allow the fish to be recognised in the tournament. A capture needing to equal or exceed the line class used is one of the fundamental requirements – even for Juniors.

Sharks for some of our competitors are a targeted species. Snappy Tom did not disappoint capturing the only Tag and Release shark for the tournament keeping her master shark fisherman status intact.

Social functions are an integral part of these tournaments. Our Friday night registrations and briefing, the tournament function held at the clubrooms on Sunday and the Monday presentation were all very well attended.
