



Invitation to participate in the MBGLAC



March Marlin Tag and Release Friendly 2024

Objective

To encourage the broadest participation of members and visitors to target our iconic marlin fishery.

There will be open sharing of experiences with the objective of maximizing all or success during the month.

Rules

Boats must be owned by MBGLAC members

Members and visitors may fish in the team

Tag and release points as per NSW GFA tag and release point score system

Individual tag and release points accrue to the boat total

Where a MBGLAC member has tag and released their first marlin, double points accrue to the boat

Fishing commences 6am 1 March and concludes 7pm 31 March

Boundaries are all waters between Goalen Head to the North (360 33"S) and the Southern-most point of Disaster Bay to the South (370 19"S)

Boats can launch from any of our boundary ramps.

All tag and releases will be reported through the Lakeview Trophy Board portal on the MBGLAC Web Site.

Awards

Highest point score boat \$200 and the Don O'Connell Perpetual Trophy

Second Highest point score boat \$100

Highest point score MBGLAC Member \$150

Second Highest point score MBGLAC Member \$50

Highest Point Score Junior (under 16 years of age on 1 March 2024) \$100

Other notes

Registration is not required – just submit your tag cards after your trip.

Skipper has complete flexibility in who he chooses to fish on board during the month

Members may also like to register their boat into a directory to assist in identification at sea and on land to better aid communications.

Awards will be made at the MBGLAC Presentation Night.
